

# Here for you, Nebraska

### More people now qualify for a low-cost or no-cost health plan through Heritage Health Adult Expansion. Are you one of them?

You might be eligible for health care with UnitedHealthcare Community Plan. Medicaid has expanded its health care coverage for adults, ages 19-64, in Nebraska. This means that more residents than ever will be eligible for the low-cost health coverage they deserve. This may now include you. To help you understand the process and make sure you receive the health coverage you need, below are some key details.

#### Who is eligible?

Low-cost health coverage is available to Nebraska adults, ages 19-64, who are not eligible for or already in Medicare, and meet income requirements.

#### What are the income requirements?

You may qualify for Heritage Health Adult Expansion plan, if:

- You're single and earn less than \$17,600 per year.
- You have a family of four living on less than \$36,000 per year.

#### What benefit packages are available?

**Basic coverage.** A comprehensive benefits package that includes outpatient services, hospitalization, mental health and substance use disorder services, prescription drugs, disease management, transportation and more.

**Prime coverage.** Includes basic benefits, plus dental care, vision services and select over-the-counter medications. Coverage is available for eligible Nebraskans who are 19 or 20 years old, pregnant, or medically frail.
